Think of a word or phrase that can be used as a starting point. For the Wavelength project, this was used as follows:

Write the phrase as above down the side of a flipchart sheet. The task is to write sentences that begin with each letter that can be turned into a song. It doesn't have to rhyme. Certain lines can be repeated to make a chorus. It may be good to have an overall theme to help participants to focus their ideas.
