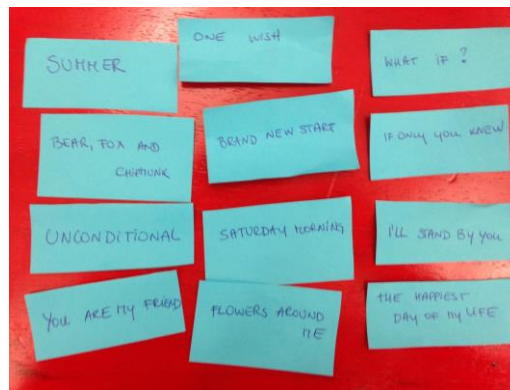


WAYS TO APPROACH WRITING LYRICS

USING A TITLE AS A STARTING POINT (USED BY MELDRA GUZA)

Using the title as a starting point can be a great way to start as inspiration for the chorus and then the rest of the song.



- You can either prepare some suggestions to give to people or you can have a discussion around coming up with ideas for the titles. You can always use existing song titles, book titles or just single words if the group is struggling to come up with ideas!
- Once you have some ideas, use the titles and use the following questions to start the songwriting process!
 - 1) What could be said if this was song's title?
 - 2) What emotions could they create?
 - 3) What kind of music would suit the title?
 - 4) What kind of chords would I use (e.g. major, minor)?
 - 5) Shall we write from our own experiences, about someone we know, or would this be completely fictional?
